Formulation of Certain Certificate and Diploma Courses related to Veterinary and Animal Sciences for implementation of New Education Policy 2020 in RAJUVAS

The House deliberated on the agenda at length in view of the New Education Policy-2020. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor apprised the House that to cater the need of trained human resource for livestock sector and to provide ample opportunities to youth for self-employment and ensuring sustainable livelihood resources to animal owners University should start some need based training certificate diploma programmes as vocational courses depending upon strength in line of the programmes started by TANUVAS recently. Certain Diploma and Certificate courses be designed for improving professional compe-tence graduates and post-graduates for State of the art diagnostic, treatment services and improving animal productivity including wildlife and disaster management, scope of Veterinary Ayurveda/ethnoand homeopathy veterinary practices etc. Every department of all the three colleges should work on this. They should come out with proposals through their respective Deans. He also directed all the Deans of constituent colleges to take initiative in this regard. Faculty Chairman to put up a comprehensive proposal in this regard in next meeting of Academic Council.

The matter regarding feasibility of opening of new Veterinary College at Pokran as desired by Government of Rajasthan was also discussed. Looking to the scope of animal



	8	husbandry in this area and to cater the need, the House resolved to communicate the scope of such Institution to the Government. However, decision has to be taken by the Government.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor apprised the House that at present 91 constituent and affiliated AHDP Institutes are running AHDP Course Programme and about 7500 students are getting admissions every year. The House unanimously recomm-ended to send a letter to State Government to assess the requirement of Diploma holders in the State in view of job opportunities and also scope of self-employment. And accordingly decide whether to allow such new Institutions in future.

However, whether new Veterinary Colleges be allowed or not in private sector, Government may be requested to access the same through a team of experts in view of requirement and scope of self or government employability in the State.
23/06	Inspection of Private Affiliated Veterinary Colleges and Animal Husbandry Diploma Institutes	The issue of inspection and affiliation fee of private affiliated veterinary colleges and AHDP Institutes was discussed at length. The House resolved to enhance the affiliation fees from Rs. 25000 to Rs. 50000.00 plus GST and Inspection fees from

House resolved that Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan and Chancellor of RAJUVASS will preside over the Convocation function, Hon'ble Minister, AH, Government of Rajasthan and Dr. B.N. Tripathi, DDG (Animal Science), ICAR be requested to be the Guests of Honour and Padam Shree Prof. (Dr.) M.L. Madan,
