GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE CANDIDATES

- Candidates are advised to read the information booklet very carefully before filling up the online application form.
- Candidates shall have to pay application fee amounting to **Rs. 3000/-** (Applicable for all categories) through NET banking/Debit Card using online gateway mode available only on university website **www.rajuvas.ac.in**. Cheque//Demand draft will not be accepted. Bank transection charges, if any are extra on this amount of Rs. 3000/-.
- Candidates are advised to fill up the application form carefully. In case of incomplete or wrongly filled forms, the fee deposited will not be refunded.
- Candidates are also advised to print a copy of the on-line uploaded application form and Proof of Payment of fee (NET banking/Debit Card) for their personal records. It may be used any time in support of having submitted application and examination fee.
- **The admit card will not be sent to the candidates by post/email.**
- **The candidate has to download admit card from the website of the University **www.rajuvas.ac.in**.**
- Candidate should bring the following documents at the time of examination, positively:

- Admissions to Post Graduate Degree Programme (M.V.Sc./Ph.D) shall be made on the basis of merit in Pre-PG Test (2025-26) conducted by RAJUVAS, Bikaner.
- Admissions to M.V.Sc./Ph.D degree programme in the constituents' colleges of RAJUVAS, Bikaner i.e. College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner and College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Navania (Udaipur) as well as

constituent college of RUVAS (Jobner) Jaipur i.e. PGIVER, Jaipur will be made through Pre-PG Test (2025-26) conducted by RAJUVAS, Bikaner.

- Candidates must have passed the qualifying examination on or before the date of counselling for admission following Pre-PG Test 2025-26.
- Bikaner court alone shall have jurisdiction to determine all disputes pertaining to the interpretation of provisions of PRE- PG Test (2025-26)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR M.V.Sc and Ph.D. ADMISSIONS

The Indian National of Rajasthan domicile only will be eligible for admission on State and Payment seats for M.V.Sc and Ph.D degree programmes. The valid domicile certificate of Rajasthan state has to be produced by the candidate at the time of counselling.

M.V. Sc Degree Programme:

- The candidate must have passed B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree examination with not less than 6.0/10.0 or equivalent OGPA/equivalent percentage (i.e. 60%) of marks for general category candidates and 5.5/10.0 or equivalent OGPA/equivalent percentage (i.e. 55%) of marks for OBC/SC/ST/ STA/MBC/ EWS/PH/Defence or any other applicable category as per reservation policy of Govt. of Rajasthan.
- The admissions shall be made on the basis of merit in Pre-PG Test (2025-26) conducted by RAJUVAS, Bikaner.
- State Reservation Policy will be applicable on all the admissions for State quota seats.
- The relevant certificates of eligibility of the candidate will have to be furnished by the candidate at the time of counselling.

Ph.D. Degree Programme:

- The candidate must have passed Master's degree in respective/related subjects with not less than 6.5/10.0 or equivalent OGPA/equivalent percentage of marks for general category candidates and 6.0/10.0 or equivalent OGPA/equivalent percentage of marks for SC/ST/STA/OBC/MBC/ EWS/PH/Defence or any other applicable category as per reservation policy of Govt. of Rajasthan.

- The admissions shall be made on the basis of merit in Pre-PG Test (2025-26) conducted by RAJUVAS, Bikaner.
- State Reservation Policy will be applicable on all the admissions for State quota seats.
- The relevant certificates of eligibility of the candidate will have to be furnished by the candidate at the time of counselling.

Important Note:

1. There will be **one (01) supernumerary seat** in M.V.Sc. & Ph.D. degree programme in each discipline reserved for **field functionaries** working as Veterinary Officer/Senior Veterinary Officer/any other permitted designation and issued NOC for pursuing higher studies by the Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Rajasthan or any other employer at the time of admission.
2. **Pre-PG Test (2025-26) for admission in M.V.Sc and Ph.D degree programme will be compulsory for all candidates belonging to field functionaries deputed by their respective employers and Inservice candidates of RAJUVAS, Bikaner.**
3. There will be provision of bonus marks for field functionaries and in-service candidates in Pre-PG and Pre-Ph.D Entrance examination. All eligible in-service candidates shall be provided incentive of 10% of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test for each year of service, up to maximum of 30% of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test.
4. **In-service candidates have to upload the certificate of experience from the competent authority at the time of filling of online application form.**
5. Admission to any study programme in the University cannot be claimed by a candidate as a matter of right. In case, a person is refused admission by the Admission Board based on any specific reason despite his/her having secured such merit by which he/she stands higher than the last admitted candidate of his/her category, such candidate will be given a hearing by the Admission Board. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor in this regard shall be final.
6. **Candidates admitted through ICAR counselling** based on score in ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2025 and ICAR AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.) 2025 for M.V.Sc./Ph.D. Degree Programmes, respectively **did not require to apply online for Pre-PG test**; however, they have to report physically on the respective counselling dates and venue declared by the university.

RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR ADMISSION

The reservation policy of Government of Rajasthan will be followed for admissions to Master's and Ph.D. programmes, however, in the event of any seat falling vacant due to non-availability of applicants/candidates of a particular reservation category from the reservation quota or UR, then such vacant seat shall be filled up with the students falling next in merit and belonging to any other categories as per the State Reservation Policy.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION AND SYLLABUS

For M.V.Sc. degree programme:

It is a type of competitive examination; therefore, no syllabus can be prescribed. It is an exercise to pick up the best. However, for guidance to the candidates, the Syllabus and the Standard of the PRE-PG TEST (2025-26) will be that of B.V.Sc & A.H standard prescribed by Veterinary Council of India and adopted by Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner. The probable number of questions from each discipline will almost equally be distributed as mentioned under:

- ❖ The question paper will be in the form of a test booklet containing 100 questions bearing number 1 to 100.
- ❖ There would be four suggested answers (A, B, C, D) to each question. The candidates are required to choose and write the correct answer in the provided space in the OMR sheet.
- ❖ The test booklet will be collected from the students at the end of the examination.
- ❖ **One mark will be awarded for every correct answer and there will be no negative marking.**
- ❖ Merit of candidates will be notified on university website.

For Ph.D degree programme:

It is a type of competitive examination; therefore, no syllabus can be prescribed. It is an exercise to pick up the best. However, for guidance to the candidates, the syllabus and the standard of the PRE-PG TEST (2025-26) will be that of M.V.Sc standard of respective discipline prescribed by ICAR and adopted by Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner.

- ❖ The Question paper will consist of multiple-choice objective type questions.
- ❖ The question paper will be in the form of a test booklet containing 100 questions bearing number 1 to 100.
- ❖ There would be four suggested answers (A, B, C, D) to each question. The candidates are required to choose and write the correct answer in the provided space.
- ❖ The test booklet will be collected from the students at the end of the examination.
- ❖ **One mark will be awarded for every correct answer and there will be no negative marking.**
- ❖ Merit of candidates will be notified on university website.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE CANDIDATES FOR PRE-PG TEST (2025-26)

1. Candidates are requested to reach at examination center at least 1 hour before the commencement of examination for security reasons and personal verification etc.
2. **No candidate shall be allowed entry in the examination center after 10.45 AM, whatsoever may be the reason of delay. After 10.45 AM the doors of examination center will be closed.**
3. A seat marked with Roll Number will be allotted to each candidate. The candidate should ensure that he/she occupies the allotted seat only. Any candidate discovered to have occupied the seat of another candidate shall be turned out from the examination and also have to accept any other penalty imposed on him/her by the Center Superintendent.
4. Candidates are required to bring their own **blue ball point pens** for answering the question paper.
5. They are not allowed to carry any textual material, written or printed, bits of papers, envelop or any other material except the original Admit Card inside the examination hall.
6. Mobile phone/calculator/side rules/log table/laptop or any other electronic gadgets etc. are strictly prohibited in the examination hall.
7. The candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items to the venue of the examination as arrangement for their safe keeping cannot be assured.
8. Candidates should carefully read the instructions and the questions given in the question paper booklet before they begin to write their answers.
9. **The question paper will be set in English language only.**
10. No second question paper booklet shall be given.
11. Soon after the question paper booklet is given to the candidate, he/she should ensure within 10 minutes of the issue of question paper booklet that it contains all the pages and no question is missing. If there is any discrepancy, he/she should point out at once to the invigilator.
12. Before attempting the answers, the candidate shall write his/her roll number, date etc. at the place provided for the purpose on the test-booklet. The candidate should choose and write the correct answer at the

space provided for the purpose in the booklet itself otherwise his/her answer will not be evaluated.

13. The candidate should not write his/her name or mark any sign/mark on any place in the test booklet or answer sheet which may disclose his/her identity. Non-compliance of this rule shall be punishable as per rules for unfair means.
14. No candidates shall leave his/her seat during examination without the permission of the invigilator in charge.
15. During the course of examination, the candidate shall be under the discipline and control of the Center Superintendent and shall abide by the instructions issued during the examination by the invigilators or the Centre Superintendent.
16. No candidate shall be permitted to leave the examination room before completion of the examination i.e. 1.00 PM.
17. Candidate found acting in a manner, which in the opinion of the invigilator, is liable to give unfair advantage to another candidate, and shall be forthwith suspended from the examination by the Centre Superintendent.
18. The invigilators, the flying squad and the examination supervisory staff shall be competent to take search of any candidate to find out whether the candidate possesses any objectionable material. Refusal by the candidate to be searched would raise the presumption that he/she is in possession of objectionable material. A candidate possessing objectionable material or resisting search shall be punishable as per rules concerning unfair means.
19. Candidate resorting to use of unfair means shall be turned out of the examination hall/room and the examination shall be treated as cancelled as a whole. The Centre supervisory staff shall be judge to determine whether unfair means have been resorted to. He will submit the report stating full facts of the case of unfairness to the controller/coordinator of examinations for further necessary action.
20. Smoking and other intoxicants are strictly prohibited in the examination hall/room.
21. Candidate should note carefully that there will be no re-evaluation of the test booklet.
22. Merit of the candidates will be displayed /uploaded on university website.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR COUNSELLING

All eligible candidates standing in merit of Pre-PG Test and willing to take admission shall report positively on notified date for Counselling before a committee constituted by the Faculty Chairman and Dean, CVAS, Bikaner under his Chairmanship, which shall prepare the final merit list for admission in each subject.

1. **The candidates will not be issued any letter to attend counselling.**
2. The candidate who stands in merit list in the declared result on the university website are advised to positively attend the counselling on the scheduled date and time.
3. There is no provision of TA/DA to the candidates for attending counselling by the University.
4. The admission to various programmes will be done strictly on the basis of merit- cum- reservation as applicable.
5. The candidates eligible for counselling will be asked for their option and entertained only for that subjects/College/Institute for which the vacancy is available at the time of their counselling.
6. Candidate securing equal marks in the Pre-PG entrance test will be admitted in the following order of preference: one who has secured more marks in the Master's/Bachelor's Degree examination followed by Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) or its equivalent.
7. The University reserves the right to admit or reject admission of any candidate without assigning any reason.
8. Mere fulfillment of a minimum requirement for a particular class does not give a candidate right to admission.
9. If for reason to be recorded in writing the admission committee suspects that a particular candidate has obtained a certificate by mis-representing facts, the admission committee would take the final decision regarding the admission of the candidate.
10. Document not found confirming to eligibility requirement may lead to disqualification.
11. At the time of counselling, the candidate who is called for allotment of seat must present himself/herself before the committee and if allotted the seat

after verification of the documents, he/she must deposit the prescribed University/college fee.

12. The candidate failing to report in the college after admission on stipulated date will not be further entertained and his total amount of fees will be forfeited.
13. Candidates admitted through ICAR counselling have to report on the counselling date by the University for taking admission to M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. programmes and have to deposit their prescribed fee of the university on counselling date.
14. All the original certificates and mark sheets must be brought by the candidate at the time of counselling and prescribed fee has to be deposited at the time of allotment of the seat, failing which the admission will be given to the next candidate in the merit.

DENIAL AND CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

- a) The admission of an applicant suppressing any information or giving wrong information or facts or forging his/her signature or of his/her parents or attaching false certificates shall be cancelled at any stage before or after admission as well as during progression of the degree programme, which shall be in addition to any other punishment that may be awarded to him/her for concealment of facts.
- b) Following candidates shall not be given admission in any of the constituent colleges of the University, even if they are qualified in Pre-PG Teat (2025-26) or nominated through ICAR counselling:
 - i. A candidate against whom any FIR has been lodged by the University or any of the constituent or affiliated private veterinary colleges or by any other competent authority/officer of the University.
 - ii. A candidate who has been punished by the university under Rules of Discipline.

- (viii) Character certificate issued from the college last attended
- (ix) Caste certificate from the competent authority, if applicable

- (xi) Person with disability (PwD) Certificate from competent authority as per provision, if applicable
- (xii) No Objection Certificate from Employer (Competent authority) if employed

The admission of candidates found unsuitable in Physical Fitness will be cancelled and, in such cases, fee will be forfeited.
