



Minutes of the 37th meeting of the Board of Management of Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner was held on 30th May, 2026 at 11.00 in the Meeting Hall of VC Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner

The 37th meeting of the Board of Management was held on 30th May, 2026 at 11.00 AM in the Meeting Hall of V.C. Secretariat, RAJUVAS, Bikaner under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Dr. Sumant Vyas.

The list of Members as well as Invitees present in the meeting has been enclosed as **Annexure-1.**

At the outset, Dr. Sumant Vyas, Vice-Chancellor, RAJUVAS, extended warm welcome to all the members of BOM external members namely Sh. Vishwanath Meghwal Ji, MLA, Khajuwala (through online mode); Prof. Govind Sahay Shukla, Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Rajasthan Ayurved University, Jodhpur; Sh. Jagmal Singh Raika; Sh. Karan Singh Rajpurohit; Smt. Madhu Kumawat; Dr. Indrajeet Singh, Dr. Govind Sahay Goutam as well as Prof. (Dr.) B.N. Shringi, Dean and Chairman Faculty and Prof. (Dr.) R.K. Dhuria, Director Extension Education, RAJUVAS, Bikaner.

He also welcomed the Representative of Secretary, AH - Dr. Kuldeep Choudhary, Addl. Director, AH; Representative of Secretary, Finance - Sh. Dheeraj Joshi, Treasury Officer, Bikaner; Representative of MD, RCDF, Jaipur - Sh. Rishabh Godara, Asstt. Director, Urmul Dairy, Bikaner; Representative of Director, AH - Dr. Sudhir Bhargava, SVO, AH; Representative of Director, Fisheries - Dr. Lovedeep Sharma, FDO, Fisheries and Invitee Sh. Vinod Kumar Yadav, Comptroller, RAJUVAS, Bikaner.

Vice-Chancellor in his introductory remark made the house aware about various ongoing teaching, research and extension activities of the University. Prof. (Dr.) R.K. Dhuria, Director Extension Education, RAJUVAS, Bikaner presented Power Point Presentation depicting the strength of University in the area of teaching, research and extension. He also made the house aware about the steps taken with regard to e-Governance, Solar installation, availability of students data on ABC, biometric attendance of students, WhatsApp groups, water harvesting system, MOUs undertaken with different organizations, information about patents already received, and under consideration, sanctioned and filled posts of teaching and non-teaching staff, intake of students in various degree programmes & diploma course, etc. All the members appreciated the presentation.

All the Hon'ble members also welcomed Dr. Sumant Vyas and assured for their full cooperation for overall progress so that University can attain new heights during his tenure.



After the opening remarks of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Sh. Pankaj Sharma, RAS, Registrar took up the agenda items one by one and resolved as follows -

Further, the fee for the payment seat for all categories is also decided to increase from Rs. 40,000 to Rs. 60,000 for MVSc degree programme and from Rs. 60,000 to Rs. 80,000 for Ph.D. degree programme from the Academic Session 2025-26. House also advised the Dean, PGS for making said corrections noted in the Information Bulletin at his level. (Action: Dean, PGS)



37/05	Recruitment process for vacant non-teaching posts in Rajasthan Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Bikaner through Rajasthan Staff Selection Board, Jaipur.	The Registrar apprised the House regarding the proposed amendments to the University Statutes—in accordance with the directives issued vide Letter No. 697 dated December 31, 2025, from the Secretary to the Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan, Jaipur—to facilitate the recruitment for non-teaching positions at the Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (RAJUVAS), Bikaner, through the Rajasthan Staff Selection Board, Jaipur. He further informed the House that, since the inception of RAJUVAS, no recruitment has taken place for the aforementioned positions; consequently, due to the retirement of a majority of the regular staff members, a significant number of posts currently lie vacant. The absence of regular human resources has adversely impacted the teaching, research, and extension services across the various units of the University. He also pointed out that, under the University's current Acts and Statutes, the University possesses the authority to conduct recruitment for non-teaching positions at its own level, in strict adherence to the norms and syllabus prescribed by the Rajasthan Staff Selection Board, Jaipur/RPSC. After detailed discussion on the agenda item, the Hon'ble Members resolved to forward a proposal to the Administrative Department with information to “Lok Bhawan” regarding the necessary amendments to the University Acts and Statutes, in compliance with the directives issued by the Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan and Chancellor of University mandating that recruitment for non-teaching positions be conducted through the Rajasthan Staff Selection Board, Jaipur/RPSC. 37/06	Regularization and Pensionary Benefits of 'Ex-Cadre' (Daily-Wage) employees	The Registrar apprised the House in detail regarding the agenda and highlighted about the directions of



		Hon'ble High Court and committees constituted at University level for considering the Representation of remaining 27 ex-cadre employees who were retired or passed away. He cleared that pensionary benefits to 23 ex-cadre employees (total 50 ex-cadre candidates were there) was already granted on the directives of Hon'ble High Court. Considering the recommendations of committees dated 16.04.2024 and dated 04.09.2025 and previously benefits already granted to 23 ex-cadre employees, House unanimously resolved to approve that the similar actual pensionary benefits shall be disbursed effective from the date of issue of order of this decision. This decision shall remain subject to the final outcome of the writ petition pending at Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan. (Action: Registrar)
37/07	Providing two Bigha Land to AVVNL for establishment of 33/11 KV GSS feeder to ensure uninterrupted electricity supply at CVAS, Navania (Udaipur)	House discussed on the agenda at length and looking to the necessity of uninterrupted power supply at CVAS, Navania campus, which is located in remote (rural) area, resolved to provide two bigha land to AVVNL for establishment of 33/11 KV GSS feeder. House advised that unutilized land may be provided so that other activities of the college like farming etc. are not hampered. (Action : Registrar and Dean, CVAS, Navania)
37/08	Any other agenda with permission of the chair	
(1)	Issue of contractual employees (through placement agency) was also discussed.	It was resolved that since the case is subjudice, the outcome of case be awaited.

At the conclusion of the meeting following suggestion/observation made by Hon'ble Members:

- 1- Shri Jagmal Singh Raika, Hon'ble Member of the Board of Management, suggested that students who have obtained their degrees from this University/College should be accorded priority for temporary appointments whenever such a need arises. The Registrar informed that the University will act in accordance with the rules and regulations of the University as well as GOR in this regard.



- 2- Shri Karan Singh Rajpurohit, Hon'ble Member of the Board of Management, suggested that the minutes of the meeting be recorded in both Hindi and English languages to ensure that the decisions taken during the meeting are understood with greater clarity. Accepting this suggestion, it was decided that the minutes of the Board of Management meetings would henceforth be issued in both languages.
- 3- Smt. Madhu Kumawat, Hon'ble Member of the Board of Management, suggested that special efforts be undertaken to enhance the University's sources of revenue, thereby strengthening its financial position. She further suggested to develop some facilities under CSR from some Bhamashahs. She would personally make efforts to solicit support and contributions for the University from Bhamashahs.
- 4- Dr. Indrajeet Singh, Hon'ble Member of the Board of Management, suggested that all necessary amenities be made available to students within classrooms and hostels. The University Administration gave an assurance that they would address the identified deficiencies and take steps to further improve and strengthen facilities like mess, toilet facility, canteen, cleanliness in campus etc.
- 5- Dr. Sudhir Bhargava, Representative of the Director of the Department of Animal Husbandry, suggested that initiation of PG courses at CVAS, Jodhpur will be a positive step and the University may install solar power system at its own level to generate additional revenue.
- 6- All the Hon'ble Members of BOM expressed concern over the large number of vacant academic positions. It was unanimously resolved that, in order to provide quality education to students and in alignment with the sentiments of the Board of Management, a fresh proposal be submitted to the State Government seeking permission for recruitment of teaching positions. The objective is to ensure the smooth functioning of academic operations within the colleges and to fulfill the standards prescribed by the Veterinary Council of India (VCI).

All the suggestions and observations were duly noted and will be acted upon after discussion with concerned departmental authorities.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
